



Statute of Historical Contest for 100 Years Anniversary of Regaining Independence by Poland

GENERAL STATEMENTS

1. Terminology

For necessities of present Statute certain terms are defined:

1. Contest: is defined as „**Konkurs historyczny na 100 lecie odzyskania przez Polskę Niepodległości**”. This Contest is realized in an internet program that is available on a Website and is determined by the statute.
2. Contest’s Organizer: Foundation of Polish Newspaper Clubs located in Cracow on Bracka 15 Street, post code: 31-005, registered with KRS (National Court Register) number: 0000437460 in the Register of associations, other social and professional organizations, foundations and separate public institutions of healthcare (subject had been also registered in the Register of Entrepreneurs), governed by National Court Register, NIP number: 6772371797 and REGON number: 122685213.
3. Contestant: person who fulfills conditions that are mentioned hereafter in section 5.
4. Winner of the Contest: person who fulfills conditions that are mentioned hereafter in section 5.
5. Statute: present statute of the Contest.
6. Website: determines website that figures under an address: www.klubygp.pl , on which the contest is performed, that belongs to the Subject organizing the Contest.
7. Duration of the Contest: period from 15th of August 2018 to 30th of November 2018, in which the contest will be conducted.
8. Furthermore, the definitions of other terms used herein can be indicated in the content of the Statute.

2. The Scope of the Contest

1. The contest will be conducted on the Website in the Duration of the Contest.
2. Contest questions will be published on the Website www.klubygp.pl every two weeks on Monday.
3. The Closure of each stage will be on the 5th day from the publication of the Contest questions.

3. Jury

1. The Jury consists of three persons designated by the Contest Organizer.



2. The Jury ensures correctness of the Contest and award the prizes, accordingly to the Statute.
3. Irrespectively of point 3.2, the Jury is a subject inspecting the Contest and arbitrating all issues related to organization accordingly to the Statute.

4. Rules of the Contest

1. The Contest consists of 10 closed questions with only one correct answer. The Contestant has a right to change answer unlimited number of times at each stage of the Contest.
2. The Winners of the Contest are 4 persons drawn from all Contestants, who will have sent correct answers to the Contest questions.
3. The Draw will be conducted on Wednesday following the Closure of each stage..
4. The list of Winners will be published during the day, when the Draw will be conducted. Recording from the Draw will be available on the Organizer.

5. The Contestants

1. The Contest participant ("The Contestant") can be every natural person, who:
 - a. has a full capacity to act in law,
 - b. is not an employee of Foundation of Polish Newspaper Clubs,
 - c. is not a member of family of an employee of Foundation of Polish Newspaper Clubs.

As a member of family mentioned hereinabove are considered: spouses, ascendants, descendants, the next of kin, cohabitants, ascendant and descendant cohabitants, relatives up to second degree of kinship.

2. Participation in the Contest is voluntary and gratuitous.
3. The condition of participating in the Contest is answering to 10 closed and single-choice questions. The Contestant must give one's name and e-mail address.
4. The condition of participating in the Contest is accepting present Statute and giving true information by the Contestant accordingly to point 5.1 and 5.3 hereinabove.
5. It is prohibited to break the rules of honest competition under penalty of disqualifying from the Contest by the Jury decision.

6. The Winner

1. The Winners of the Contest are Contestants who have sent correct answers at e-mail konkurs@klubygp.pl.
2. Contest's Organizer will inform about selecting Winners by sending each of them e-mail, at e-mail address given by the Contestant. This information will also inform about endowing the Contestant with a prize.
3. The Winner becomes a person, who fulfills conditions mentioned in point 5 hereinabove. The Jury has a right to check whether the Winner fulfills conditions mentioned in the previous sentence. In case that Contestant does not fulfill conditions from point 5 hereinabove or in case that Contestant or Winner has broken the rules stated in the Statute, the Jury can exclude the Contestant from the Contest.
4. One Winner can win only one prize.

7. The Prizes

1. The Prizes in the Contest are:
 - a. Album book about Polish history with a value of 199,00 PLN,
 - b. Music disc with patriotic music with a value of 30 PLN,
2. The Prizes that are awarded in the Contest can not be replaced with cash benefits.
3. Delivering the Prizes to the Winners by the Contest's Organizer will ensue after providing every necessary information to deliver the prize, in particular by delivering the telephone number and address.
4. In case, when the Winner will not deliver correct information necessary to delivering the prize, the Contest's Organizer reserves the right to choose other Contestant, to whom the prize will be awarded in some part or whole or not awarding this prize at all, accordingly to the Statute.
5. The Winner is obliged to deliver correct information necessary to delivering the prize.

FINAL PROVISIONS

8. Personal Data

1. The administrator of personal data transmitted and processed in connection with the Contest is Foundation of Polish Newspaper Clubs with office in Cracow on Bracka 15 Street and post code 31-005.



2. Transmitting and processing of personal data is executed accordingly to valid regulations regarding the protection of personal data and in accordance with the Contestants agreement, expressed before entering the Contest.
3. The Contestants are vested with a right to access, edition and requirement to delete their data. Delivering their data is voluntary but necessary to receive the Prizes and considering possible complaints.
4. Transmitting and processing of personal data will be used in order to properly execute the Contest and consider complaints.

9. Complaints

1. Complaints will be considered in period of 14 days after delivering the Complaint and they can be reported during the duration of the Contest and 14 days after the Contest ends. The Complaints should be sent together with explanation by mail on the address of Contest's Organizer showed hereafter Fundacja Klubów Gazety Polskiej, ul.Bracka 15, 31-005 Kraków and with indicating e-mail address, at which the Contest's Organizer shall send reply.
2. Replies will be sent by e-mail at e-mail address indicated by the Contestant in the content of Complaint.

10. Accesibility of the Statute and General Rules of the Contest

The Statute is available in the Organizer office, the headquarters of subject ordering the Contest and on the Website.

11. Final Provisions

1. The Contestant is obliged not to interfere with course of the Contest in any way that would be contradictory with law, the Statute or customs. For interfering with the course of the Contest will be considered any actions disturbing Contest's rules and course intended by the Contest Organizer. The Contestant is obliged not to decompile, use scripts, interfere with data base using other sources than tools prepared by the Contest's Organizer, interfere with computer software and undertaking other actions in order to gain other advantages in the Contest.
2. In case of changing e-mail address given by the Contestant, the Contestant is obliged to inform the Contest's Organizer about the change by sending e-mail at e-mail address konkurs@klubygp.pl.



3. The Contestant can resign from participating in the Contest by sending e-mail with an information of such resignation at e-mail address konkurs@klubygp.pl from an e-mail given in the application. The Contest's Organizer will delete any answer to Contest questions send after the resignation.
4. The Contest's Organizer is authorized to change present Statute in any time, because of important reasons under a condition that this action will not breach the rules of Contestants and fundamental rules of the Contest. The Contestants will be informed about any changes to the Statute in advance, allowing them to become familiar with the changes and possible resignation from participating in the Contest. Whether the Contestant does not accept new regulations, the Contestant has a right to withdraw from the Contest without any consequences.
5. Matters that are not mentioned in the Statute are liable to the law.
